SAINTS OF THE WEEK


April 11: Saint Stanislaus, Bishop, Martyr

Stanislaus, † 1079; as bishop of Craxow, he assisted the poor; slain by the oppressive and savage king, Boleslaus II the Bold; patron of Poland.



April 13: Saint Martin I, Pope, Martyr

Martin, † 656; as a deacon, served at the imperial court in Constantinople; combated emperor Constans II (reigned 641-668) over Monothelite belief that Jesus had only a divine will and so was not truly human; as pope, forced from Rome to Constantinople where he was tried for treason; later exiled to Crimea where he died of starvation and ill-treatment; last pope to be martyred.
